## Quick Takes at MPS

- Graduation rate: 100% last school year
- Proud achievement in state accountability: Significant improvement, above-state-average numbers in most grades and subject areas

2017-18 is the first year that the NSCAS exam was administered, including grades 3rd-8th. Assessment scores improved and are above the state average in all areas.

Math and English assessments show state scores vs. the state average from 2018, which is more rigorous. Language Arts developed new state standards in 2017. Mathematics developed new state standards in 2018. Math and English are based on performance of developing, on track, and college and career readiness. Science will transition to the new state standards in 2021 and be assessed in the spring of 2021.

The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Hayes, and Lincoln.
- Special education & Title I services are provided to all students in need as well as higher learning opportunities.
- More than 48 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.



## ...Stories of growth

- Enrollment over the last three years, 2015-16-163, 2016-17-168, 2017-18-170, 2018-19-166
- The elementary preschool has 21 students that attend the program.
- *Students will improve writing skills in all subject areas.* This goal drives school improvement efforts at MPS. This current school year is the five year external visit.
- New elective class offerings, photography, building construction
- Maywood High School is in the fifth year of an athletic cooperation with Hayes Center High School. The Wolves have done a great job of competing and growing as a team each year in the COOP.

## ...Stories in stewardship

- The 2018-19 budget for MPS was \$5,676,619.69
- The General Fund property tax asking for 2018-19 was .841618 and the Special Building Fund property tax asking was .002915 for a total tax asking of .844533.
- The 2018-19 cost per pupil at MPS was \$21,999.
- State Aid (TEEOSA) \$127,099
- Other state receipts \$349,159

## ...Stories in accountability

- Maywood Public Schools' ACT composite score growth over the last two years: 19.8 in 2017 and 21.2 in 2018. In 2018, the state average for the ACT was 20.1, MPS juniors were 21.2. In 2019 the state average was 20.0 and MPS juniors averaged 18.94 on the ACT
- All high school students are offered an online course for ACT test preparation.
- Multiple on-line college courses were completed by upper grade students.
- The AQuESTT rating improved from "good" to "great".
