Quick Takes at MPS

- Graduation rate: 100% for the 2021 school year
- Nebraska state accountability remains the same as a result of Coronavirus. District rating is “Great.”
- Tax levy rate: Almost 18.5 cents below the NE levy limit
District tax levy is 86.48 cents, down 1.5 cents.
- Employment: 41 Employees work for the MPS district
- Demographics: 401 square miles make up the district in Frontier, Hayes and Lincoln County
- Option enrollment: 89 students from other school districts choose to attend Maywood Public Schools.

*Beginning in 2017, 11th grade was tested via the ACT. 2017-18 is the first year that NSCAS/AQuESTT exams were administered, in grades 3rd-8th and 11th Grade. 2020 –21 students in grades 5, and 8 will pilot the new NSCAS science assessments, while no scores will be released in 2021. NSCAS ELA Assessments utilize revised testing MAPS for Growth style assessments. This will allow MPS to test up to 3 times per year to measure growth.

Maywood students exceed state proficiency scores in mathematics assessment.

...Stories in rich demographics

The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Hayes, and Lincoln.
- Special education services are provided to all students in need as well as higher learning opportunities. Services are delivered in mainstreamed classrooms.
- Currently 50 percent of our students live in poverty (Free/Reduced lunch).
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.
- All MPS students received free breakfast and lunch for 2021-2022 resulting from Coronavirus funding by the U.S. D. A. School Lunch Program



...Stories of growth

- Enrollment at MPS reflects positive growth of 28 students over last year.
- The elementary preschool has 27 students attending the program.
- *Students will improve in reading & writing skills in all subject areas.*
- Maywood High School is in the seventh year, of a ten year athletic cooperation, with Hayes Center The MHC Wolves are doing a great job competing and growing as a team .
- Lady Wolves Volleyball participated in the 2021 State Tournament finishing third!
- Boys & Girls basketball teams participated in NSHAA basketball tournament in 2021.

- The General Fund Property Tax Asking for 2021-2022 is \$2,971,859, requiring 86.4861 cents tax.
- No Special Building Fund taxes.
- The 2019 –20 cost per pupil at MPS was \$27,821 based on Average. Daily Membership.
- Adjusted General Fund Operating Expenditures per Formula Student is \$21,232
- State Aid (TEEOSA) \$333,467.
- Net Option Student Enrollment Aid: \$\$322,313
