MPS started additional ACT testing in the fall and spring of the sophomore year and fall and spring of students junior year. MPS students have experienced increased growth in their ACT scores. NSCAS assessments occurred in grades 3 – 8 using the NSCAS MAPS grade level assessments.

MPS began testing students using the i-Ready assessments for math & Reading in the fall & winter 2023. Dibels Reading assessments were given in grades to K—3 students.

The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Hayes, and Lincoln.
- Special education services are provided to all students identified on a Individualized Education Plan.
- Currently 57 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.
- Phonics has been added to the K—3 classrooms to improve student reading.
- Seven State FFA Degrees recipients and four American Degree applicants.



...Stories of Growth

- The elementary preschool has 16 students attending the program.
- Students will improve in reading comprehension.
- Students will improve writing skills in all subject areas.
- MHS is in the 11th year, athletic cooperative, with Hayes Center.
- The Wolves basketball team participated in the 2024 State Tournament finishing second!
- MPS students in grades K—equaled or exceeded the State in Math, & Science performance.



...Stories in Stewardship

- The General Fund Property Tax Asking for 2023-2024 is \$3,335,289 requiring 83.2786 cents tax. A reduction of 1.96 cents.
- One Cent for Special Building Fund taxes generating \$40,404.
- The 2023 –24 cost per pupil at MPS was \$24,464 based on Average Daily Membership.
- Adjusted General Fund Operating Expenditures per Formula Student is \$17,441
- Total State Aid (TEEOSA) \$851,336. Growth of \$167,429
- Net Option Student Enrollment Aid: \$565,908, Increase of \$170,422

...Stories in accountability

- Sophomores and Juniors participate in Fall & Spring ACT testing reflect improvement in their test scores. Juniors improved the average test scores in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science. Average score is 18.0
- Multiple Distance learning & Dual Credit classes are available to students affording greater course diversity and online learning opportunities for Maywood students.
- 92% of Maywood graduates attended either a 2 year college (53.5%) or 4 year college(38.5%).
- Chronic Absenteeism improved by 3% at 17% MPS .
