Quick Takes at MPS

- Graduation rate: 93% for the 2025 school year
- Nebraska state accountability rates the High School as "Good," the Middle School as "Great," "Elementary" as "Great," and the school district rated as "Great."
- Tax levy rate: Almost 22.5 cents below the NE levy limit District tax levy is 82.53 cents, an increase of 0.005 cents.
- Employment: 41.5 Employees work for the MPS district
- Demographics: 401 square miles make up the district in Frontier, Hayes and Lincoln County
- Option enrollment: 69 students from other school districts choose to attend Maywood Public Schools.

...Stories in Rich Demographics

The faces and voices of MPS students are varied and diverse.

- Students attend MPS from the following three counties: Frontier, Hayes, and Lincoln.
- Special education services are provided to all students identified on a Individualized Education Plan.
- Currently 52 percent of our students live in poverty.
- Preschool provides educational opportunities to students beginning at age 3.
- Phonics has been added to the K—3 classrooms to improve student reading.
- Dibels benchmark improvement grades K-3, fall score 53% and spring benchmark 80%



...Stories of Growth

- The elementary preschool has 14 students attending the program.
- *Students will improve in reading comprehension.*
- *Students will improve writing skills in all subject areas.*
- MHS is in the 12th year, athletic cooperative, with Hayes Center .
- MPS students in grades K—68equaled or exceeded the State in Math, English Language Arts & Science performance.



...Stories in Stewardship

- The General Fund Property Tax Asking for 2024-2025 is \$3,335,289 requiring .81.533 cents tax. An increase of 0.005 cents.
- One Cent for Special Building Fund taxes generating \$45,131.
- The 2024 –25 cost per pupil at MPS was \$26,353 based on Average Daily Membership.
- Adjusted General Fund Operating Expenditures per Formula Student is \$18,195
- Total State Aid (TEEOSA) \$753,898. Loss of -\$97,438
- Net Option Student Enrollment Aid: \$483,911, decrease of -\$81,997

...Stories in accountability

- Sophomores and Juniors participate in Fall & Spring ACT testing reflect improvement in their test scores. Juniors improved the average test scores in English Language Arts, Mathematics and Science. Average score is 18.0
- Multiple Distance learning & Dual Credit classes are available to students affording greater course diversity and on-line learning opportunities for Maywood students.
- 80% of Maywood graduates attended either a 2 year college (66.67%) or 4 year college(13.33%).
- Chronic Absenteeism improved by leveled off at 17% for MPS . 2.38% below the state average of 19.38%
